## CERTIFICATE III IN SURFACE EXTRACTION

This course is designed to provide you with the skills and knowledge required for surface extraction operations in mines or quarries. It also reflects the role of employees such as production operators who perform tasks such as operation of mobile plant and equipment, spreading and compacting materials and maintaining stockpile material.

This qualification is offered as a blended program consisting of recognition of prior learning and formal classroom or workplace based training and assessment.
